

SR-91 Westbound & Eastbound Lane Widening Project

Slope Removal at Imperial Highway Bridge

Project Overview

Caltrans and OCTA are adding a new six-mile lane in both the westbound and eastbound direction of SR-91 from approximately SR-55 to SR-241. The project will benefit commuters by increasing capacity, improving operations and relieving congestion, as well as delivering a better drive through Anaheim and Yorba Linda.

What: Constrction crews will begin the removal of existing slope pavement at the Imperial Highway bridge, which may result in loud noise during overnight work hours. To safely and efficiently conduct the work, nighttime closure of the outside lanes under the Imperial Highway bridge may be required. No detour is necessary as at least one lane will remain open at all times.

When: Scheduled from Monday, December 19 through Friday, December 23 from 11:59 p.m. to 4 a.m. nightly

Maximizing Safety, Maximizing Signage, Maximizing Traffic Flow

Imperial Highway will be clearly marked with electronic signage directing motorists to merge into the open lanes. While delays may occur, no detour is necessary because at least two lanes will be open in both directions throughout the work period.
