Nighttime and Daytime Express Lane, Ramp and Street Closures Weir Canyon Rd. to Imperial Hwy. January 23-27, 2012

WHAT:

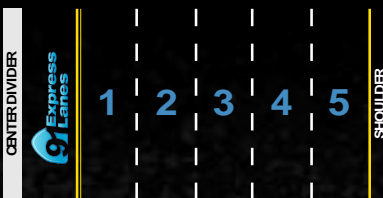
Nighttime and daytime Express Lane, ramp and street closures will continue on SR-91. The closures will allow crews to continue work on overhead freeway signage, pile driving operations at Weir Canyon Rd./Yorba Linda Blvd. and Imperial Hwy., and ramp work throughout the project area.

NOISE ALERT!

Construction crews will continue pile driving operations through the month of January from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. weekdays at the Weir Canyon Rd./Yorba Linda Blvd. and Imperial Hwy. bridges, which may result in loud, repetitive noise and vibrations.

PROJECT BENEFITS

- One new six-mile lane in the westbound and eastbound directions between SR-241 and SR-55
- Standardized 12-foot lanes and 10-foot right shoulders
- Widened undercrossing at Weir Canyon Road/Yorba Linda Blvd. and Imperial Highway in the westbound and eastbound directions
- New restriping throughout project limits
- Soundwall on eastbound side of the freeway along key residential area
