Nighttime and daytime Express Lane, ramp and street closures will continue on SR-91. The closures will allow crews to continue pile driving operations at Weir Canyon Rd./Yorba Linda Blvd., install overhead freeway signage, and begin realignment work on the eastbound Lakeview Ave. off-ramp.
